By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent No.2 to promote him as Inspector with all consequential benefits from the date when his junior was promoted i.e. w.e.f. 29.06.2010.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that though a legal notice dated October 11, 2017 (P-3) was served upon the respondents but till date no conscious decision has been taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the legal notice (P-3) within some stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievance unfolded by the petitioner in the

legal notice (P-3) and to decide the same in accordance with law, rules, regulations and instructions issued by the government of Punjab from time to time within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of afore-said authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
