By way of instant writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* for directing respondent No.2 and his authorized representatives including respondent No.3 to take immediate steps to handover peaceful vacant possession of the mortgaged properties in terms of orders dated 22.04.2014, 02.05.2014 and 26.05.2014 (Annexures P-1 to P-3) passed by respondent No.2.
