The petitioner has challenged the circular dated 30.1.2017, issued by respondent No.2, deciding not to provide electricity connection for running the tubewell in the notified area declared as dark zone.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the application was filed on 3.12.2013 whereas the circular has been issued on 30.1.2017.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after examining the available record, am of the considered opinion that in view of the circular dated 30.1.2017, electricity connection cannot be given for running the tubewell in the dark zone because of depleting water level as the water is required for drinking purposes. Therefore, the present petition is found to be without any merit and the same is hereby dismissed.
