Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that without even a show cause notice having been issued to the petitioners, their pay has been reduced vide the order Annexure P-19, passed by respondent no.4, i.e. General Manager, The Karnal Central Cooperative Bank Ltd.

A perusal of the said order shows that no reference of any show cause notice is given in the aforesaid communication, dated 23.10.2017.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority amongst the respondents to first issue a show cause notice to the petitioners with regard to re-fixation of their pay, and after hearing them by due procedure, a speaking order be passed as to why their pay has to be reduced.

The needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, and in the meanwhile the operation of the impugned order shall remain stayed, with the speaking order also not to be acted upon for one week after it has been passed.

The petitioners would make a representation in terms of the orders of this Court, within a period of 10 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, failing which the interim order shall stand vacated.

It is also made clear that if a show cause notice was served upon the petitioners, and they have been duly heard, the respondents would be at liberty to file an appropriate application for modification of this order, it having been passed without issuance of notice to them.
