Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that if the petitioner is granted one mark more for having participated in the Kedarnath All India Trek 1998, organized by the NCC Directorate, Uttar Pradesh, as per the certificate annexed as a part of Annexure P-3, he would come within the merit list, he having already secured 55.3 marks, with the last selected candidate having secured 56.01 marks.

He further submits that all the advertised posts not having been filled up by the respondents, CWP-25682-2014 was filed by candidates contended to be similarly situated, praying therein that they be appointed to the unfilled posts.

That petition is shown to have been allowed on 13.11.2017, a copy of the judgment being Annexure P-11 annexed with the petition.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents, that upon the petitioner making a detailed representation within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of

this order, the competent authority would pass a speaking order thereon, within 2 months thereafter.

If the petitioners' case is to be rejected for any reason, detailed reasons for such rejection shall be given while taking a decision on the representation.
