In respect of the grievance of the petitioners, of having been posted to a far off place other than the options they had given, despite the fact (as contended), they having marks enough to be posted to the stations of their choice, they have made representations and got issued a legal notice to the 2nd respondent herein, i.e. the Director of Elementary Education, Haryana (a copy of which has been annexed as Annexure P-9), which is stated to have still not been decided, even five months later.

Consequently, without making any comment on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority amongst the respondents, to decide the aforesaid legal notice got issued by the petitioners, by passing a speaking order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

It is also clarified that in case a speaking order has already been passed giving such detailed reasons, then only a short order need be passed in the present petitioners' case, annexing therewith the detailed order already passed (if any).
