The petitioners seek a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant deemed date of regularization as Helper Grade-I w.e.f. the date their juniors have been granted benefit alongwith 18% interest. The benefit is sought on account of the judgments passed in **LPA No.1141 of 2014 'Haryana Power Generation Corporation Ltd. and others Vs. Maha Singh'** decided on 12.09.2014 (Annexure P-8) and in **LPA No.1137 of 2014 'Haryana Power Generation Corporation Ltd. and others Vs. Surinder Singh'** decided on 12.09.2014 (Annexure P-6). It has been averred that the said order stand implemented vide order dated 06.08.2015 (Annexure P-7).

Counsel fairly submits that petitioners No.1 and 2 had served legal notice dated 03.06.2016 (Annexure P-10) alongwith other similarly situated persons, but who are retirees. In the case of retirees i.e. **CWP No.28035 of 2017 'Om Parkash Thapa and others Vs. Haryana Power Generation Corporation Limited and another'** directions had

been issued on 11.08.2017 (Annexure P-18) to decide the legal notice within a period of 3 months from the receipt of the certified copy of the order.

Counsel, accordingly, submits that similar directions be issued in the case of the petitioners and writ petition be treated as representation on behalf of petitioner No.3 also.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.1 to look into the grievances as per legal notice dated 03.06.2016 (Annexure P-10) and decide the same within 3 months from the receipt of the certified copy of this order and if found entitled be released the said benefits. The petitioner No.3 shall also supply copy of the writ petition to the said respondent.

Needless to say that, in case, any adverse order is to be passed, the same be conveyed to the petitioners by passing a speaking order.
