In the instant petition, petitioner has challenged the award passed by the labour Court dated 29.01.2016 (Anneuxre P/1).

Undisputed facts are that petitioner has worked from March, 2011 to April, 2012 for about one year so also petitioner has worked for 240 days. The labour Court relied on *BSNL V/s. Bhuru Mal 2014 SCC 177* and extended the benefit of compensation of Rs.50,000/- instead of reinstatement. Having regard to the principle laid down in the aforesaid Supreme Court decision, there is no infirmity in the order dated 29.01.2016. Thus, petitioner has not made out a case so as to interfere with the award passed by labour Court.

Accordingly, the petition stands dismissed.
