On 16.08.2016, the following order was passed:

“C.M. No. 4059-CII of 2014

Prayer in this application is for exemption from deposit of an amount of ₹ 2,24,325 along with interest as per the Award passed by the Commissioner under the Employees' Compensation Act, 1923, Sangrur dated 23.07.2013.

On perusing the application and on hearing the counsel for the applicant/appellant, this Court finds no reason to stay the deposit of the amount or for exemption from deposit of the amount of ₹ 2,24,325 along with interest.

The application, therefore, stands dismissed.

FAO No. 1213 of 2014 (O&M)

Learned counsel for the appellant prays for and is granted four weeks time to deposit the awarded amount along with interest and prays for adjournment of the appeal.

The main appeal is adjourned to 29.09.2016 to await the deposit of awarded amount along with interest.”

Resultantly, keeping in view the non-deposit of the amount, which is a mandatory condition under Section 30 of the Employees' Compensation Act, 1923, this Court has no option but to dismiss the appeal, being not maintainable.
