Petitioner who was serving on the post of Inspector Grade-I under the Department of Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, State of Punjab instituted the instant writ petition impugning a charge sheet dated 15.10.2015 (Annexure P-14) issued by the Secretary to Government of Punjab of the concerned department.

During the course of arguments today, it has gone uncontroverted that in the inquiry proceedings, which ensued upon issuance of the charge sheet, findings were returned exonerating the petitioner and such findings have been accepted by the Competent Authority.

Learned State counsel has during the course of hearing read out an order dated 12.07.2017 passed by the Principal Secretary, Department of Food Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs (in vernacular) and as per which, a decision has been taken to drop the charges that have been levelled against

the petitioner in the impugned charge sheet dated 15.10.2015.

In the light of such development, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
