Short reply, on behalf of respondents, has been filed, wherein it has been averred that the services of the petitioner have been regularized vide order dated 10.08.2017 (Annexure R-1), however, the same is subject to the final outcome of CWP-17206-2014. It has further been averred that claim of the petitioner has been settled.

A perusal of the said order would go on to show that regularization has been done w.e.f. 01.10.2003 whereas the claim of the petitioner is w.e.f. 15.01.1997.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of, with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondents for the balance relief, by filing a detailed representation. On the receipt of the same, respondent No.2 shall take a decision regarding the claim of the petitioner and whether he is entitled to the regularization from the date which he seeks, within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of the application. In case the relief is to be denied, reasoned order be passed and the same be communicated to the petitioner.
