The petitioner is aggrieved by the order Annexure P-4, whereby all the Schools in Haryana have been directed to observe winter vacation from 25.12.2017 to 08.01.2018. He submits that according to the Haryana School Education Rules 2003, a total 220 working days are mandated and this year because of public violence in Haryana caused by the followers of Baba Gurmit Ram Rahim Singh, in the month of August 2017, the schools have not been able to complete the mandated period, therefore, they wish to curtail the winter vacation. The petitioner has however, come to this Court without making any representation to the Director, Secondary Education, Haryana (respondent No. 2).

Keeping in view the above, the petitioner is permitted to make a representation today itself, to respondent No.2, who will pass a speaking order thereupon on 01.01.2018 by 13:00 hours.

This petition is disposed of accordingly.
