The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant appointment to the petitioner on compassionate ground as per Scheme of Compassionate Appointments-2002 issued by the State of Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein contends that petitioner herein is the wife of late constable Amandeep Singh, who died in harness and is seeking compassionate appointment. Learned counsel for the petitioner limits his prayer that the legal notice, as served, be decided as expeditiously as possible.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and in view of the limited prayer, I dispose of the writ petition by directing the respondents to decide the representation of the petitioner as expeditiously as possible.

The petitioner is directed to file her fresh representation along with certified

The respondents herein are directed to dispose of the said representation preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the said representation along with certified copy of the order.
