It is contended that vide an order passed by this court, services of the petitioners were to be regularized from April 06, 1992, however, despite approaching the department concerned, no such orders have been passed. The petitioners have also sent a legal notice dated May 26, 2016 seeking compliance of the orders that were passed in the CWP, which was disposed of vide order dated 10.04.1994. Learned counsel for the petitioners limits his prayer that directions may be issued to the respondents to decide the legal notice of the petitioners expeditiously.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and in view of the limited prayer, I dispose of the writ petition by directing respondents to decide the representation of the petitioners as expeditiously as possible.

The petitioners are directed to file their fresh representation along with

certified copy of this order within two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. The respondents herein are directed to dispose of the said representation preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the said representation along with certified copy of the order.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
