This petition has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to consider the claim of the petitioners for regularization like other similarly situated persons who have been regularized by the respondents-Board.

Learned senior counsel states that in this connection the petitioners have also moved legal notice (Annexure P-6) to the respondents and at this stage they would be satisfied if the legal notice is decided by the respondent No.1 within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair submission. Keeping in view the plight as portrayed, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a direction to the respondent No.1 to decide the said legal notice of the petitioners and take necessary action thereon within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. Ordered

accordingly.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
