Kuldeep Singh, J. (Oral)

Prayer of the petitioner is for correction of name and date birth of the petitioner and also correction of mother's name.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court is of the view that the change of date of birth and the correction of the names requires leading of evidence, which can only be done before the Civil Court. Since the facts are required to be proved by leading evidence, therefore, this Court is refrained from exercising the writ jurisdiction. For such matter, the petitioner is relegated to avail remedy before the Civil Court.

The writ petition is disposed of.
