The grievance of the petitioner herein is that he had approached the Director General of Police, to take appropriate action against respondents No.5 and 6 for non-compliance of the Canteen Rules, 1965, with regard to purchase for canteen of above Rs.100 crores, by filing a representation dated 06.10.2016 (Annexure P-2), but the same has not decided to date. Learned counsel for the petitioner limits his prayer to the earlier decision to be taken on the said representation
