The petitioner claims allotment of a plot under the oustees category on the premise that her land was acquired in the year 1974 and she applied for such allotment in the year 1980. The petitioner is claimed to have represented after the year 1980, in the year 2009 and then in the year 2015 only.

In our considered view, the petitioner due to her long and unexplained silence has lost her right. The petitioner has not disclosed any mitigating circumstance like meager income or any other social disability which could have prevented her from approaching the Court within a reasonable time. At this juncture when even civil suit is also barred, we decline to entertain this writ petition.

Dismissed.
