The petitioner has preferred the instant petition for issuance of direction to the respondents to grant the benefits of stepping up of the pay of the petitioner at par with Shri Munish Kumar, Traffic Sub Inspector (TSI).

A reserved category employee, who was junior to the petitioner was promoted. Thereafter the petitioner was also promoted and caught up with his erstwhile junior. He, however, complains that his pay has not been fixed as per the principle of 'catch up'. In this regard, he has given representation (Annexure P-9)

In my opinion, it would be appropriate if respondent No.1 considers on the said representation (Annexure P-9) and passes a speaking order on the same within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and in case the petitioner is found entitled to the relief claimed, the same be released to him within a further period of two

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months, failing which he would be entitled to any due relief with interest @
10% per annum.
