RAJESH BINDAL, J.

Only prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner at the time of argument was that he may be given some time to shift his factory, which is running on the acquired land since 1984 onwards. The petitioner had set up the factory after getting requisite permissions from the State. He does not have any objection to the acquisition of the land and the only apprehension is that the respondents may demolish the factory, therefore, he may be granted some time to shift his factory. There is no development activity going on around the acquired land showing that possession of the land is required immediately by the respondents. The petitioner seeks time till 30th April, 2017 to hand over vacant physical possession of the land in dispute to the competent authority on his own.

Considering the prayer made by the petitioner, we are of the opinion that the petitioner can be permitted to retain possession of the factory till 30th April, 2017 subject to the aforesaid conditions. Thereafter,

he will hand over possession to the competent authority on his own. The order is being passed considering the stand taken by the petitioner that seeing the pace of development close to the acquired land, the same is not required immediately. In case the respondents have any objection about the order passed, they shall be at liberty to file application for modification/recalling thereof.

Ordered accordingly.

The petition stands disposed of.
