The apprehension of the petitioner is that the competent authority will not act in accordance with law while dealing with his application seeking apportionment of compensation for the acquired land.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition at this stage as the petitioner has already moved an application before the competent authority seeking apportionment of compensation and he will pursue that remedy.
