The prayer made in this petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to remove illegal encroachments from land measuring 120 kanal 9 marlas bearing Khasra No.120, Killa No.1/24(1-4), 25 (4-5), Murabba No.135, Killa No.4(7-12), 5 (8-0), 6/1(5-7), 6/2 (0-13), 7/1 (3-18), 7/2 (3-9), 8/1 (0-5), 8/2 (1-11), 13 (5-10), 14 (8-0), 15 (7-17), 16(6-11), 17 (8-0), 18 (2-7), 24 (6-11), 25 (2-8), 26 (1-12), Murabba No.136, Killa No.1(8-0), 2/1 (2-4), 9/3 (2-6), 10 (8-0), 11/1 (1-0), 11/2 (6-7), 12/1 (0-12), 19/1 (1-11), 20 (6-2), Murabba No.145, Killa No.1/4 (0-11), Hadbast No.108, Village Ferozepur City, Tehsil and District Ferozepur as per Jamabandi for the year 2008-09 owned by Central Government as per **Annexure P-1** including the cold store constructed illegally in Khewat No.1805, Khatauni No.5478, Murabba No.135, Hadbast No.108, Village Ferozepur City.

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2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that inadvertently Union of India could not be impleaded as a party whereas it is necessary and proper party as the land in dispute belongs to the Central Government. She prays that she may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file fresh one on the same cause of action by impleading Union of India as necessary party.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed.
