JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

The petitioner herein is an employee of the Jalandhar Central Co-operative Bank Ltd. and being an employee of the Co-operative Bank, the petitioner sought extension in service on the basis of the amendments that have been made in the Punjab Civil Service Rules.

The request of the petitioner for extension in service came to be rejected on account of the fact that the Jalandhar Central Co-operative Bank Ltd. had not adopted the policy of the Government/Corporation to grant extension to its employees. Being aggrieved against denial in extension in

service, as well as instructions dated 04.04.2013 issued by the Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Punjab, giving discretion to the Cooperative Societies, whether or not to adopt the extension policy, the instant writ petition came to be filed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner at the very outset submits that having superannuated, he is not pressing the relief for extension in service and however, while withdrawing the instant writ petition, seeks liberty to challenge the instructions dated 04.04.2013 at an appropriate stage. It is contended that a uniform policy should be adopted regarding the grant of extension in service.

In view of the above discussion, the instant writ petition stands dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty aforesaid.
