no life to breathe in this appeal.

All the aforementioned appeals can be disposed of on the short
ground that the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Ludhiana, vide its report

dated 08.08.2016, made pursuant to the directions issued by this Court on 13.10.2015, decided issue No.4 in favour of the appellant – Ajit Singh holding that at the time of accident on 19.08.2000 Tarlochan Singh - driver held a valid driving license. Therefore, the entire burden of compensation under the awards will have to be borne by respondent No.3 – New India Assurance Company Limited and it can have no directions for giving them recovery rights against appellant Ajit Singh.

Consequently, all the appeals are allowed.
