Prayer in this application filed under Section 151 CPC is for placing on record the replication to the reply filed by the respondent Nos. 2.

For the reasons enumerated in the application, the same is allowed and the replication is taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

In view of the above, the present application is disposed of.

CWP No. 929 of 2016

The petitioner has preferred the present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ of mandamus for directing the respondents to pay arrears of salary and retiral dues of the petitioner on account of his retirement on attaining age of superannuation which has been withheld by the respondents.

CWP No. 929 of 2016 (O&M)

Learned counsel for the respondent No. 2 contended that certain payments have been claimed from the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has fairly stated that the recovery, as claimed by the respondents, may be adjusted from the amount due to him and the balance may be paid to the petitioner.

Therefore, the present petition is disposed of with direction that the amount claimed by the respondents be adjusted from the arrears due to the petitioner and the remaining amount be paid to the petitioner. For some other dispute, the parties can always approach the Registrar, Co-operative Societies, Punjab, under Section 69 of the Punjab Co-operative Societies Act, 1961.
