Petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/ 227 of the Constitution of India seeks a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to make the payment of the amount due for the work of reconstruction of Lalbai Disty from RD 0-4000, executed by him.

In this context, the petitioner had sent a legal notice, annexure P-2, to Executive Engineer, Bathinda Canal Division, Bathinda, dated January 23, 2017.

It has been contended by counsel for the petitioner that the said legal notice has not yet been considered.

Notice of motion to Advocate General, Punjab.

On the asking of the Court, Ms.Anu Pal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice. Two sets of paper book be handed over to State counsel during the course of the day.

I deem it appropriate in the interest of justice to dispose of this petition with a direction to the Executive Engineer, Bathinda Canal Division, Bathinda, to consider the claim of the petitioner as depicted in legal notice dated January 23, 2017 and pass a speaking order within a period of four months after the receipt of a certified copy of the order. Ordered accordingly.

It will be the duty of counsel for the petitioner to communicate the order to Executive Engineer, Bathinda Canal Division, Bathinda. If the representation is considered favourably and the petitioner is held entitled to any amount, the same may be released expeditiously after the decision of the claim of the petitioner.
