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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

The petitioner prays for release of the interest on the delayed payment of retiral benefits. The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner retired from service on 30.6.2015. No chargesheet or inquiry was pending against him, but the retiral benefits were released on 6.10.2016. The petitioner has already made a representation dated 16.9.2016 (Annexure-P-7), but to no avail. The short prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner at this stage is that the respondents may be directed to decide the representation dated 16.9.2016 (Annexure-P-7) by passing a speaking order.

In these circumstances, without issuing notice to the opposite party, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to decide the representation dated 16.9.2016 (Annexure-P-7) within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. If it is found that the petitioner is entitled to interest on the delayed payment of retiral

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benefits as per instructions dated 30.4.1998/4.5.1998 (Annexure-P-5), the same shall be released, otherwise speaking order be passed, denying the claim.
