The Estate Officer, Punjab Urban Development Authority, Amritsar, vide impugned order has cancelled the allotment of petitioners' plots due to non-deposit of 15% of the allotment price within 30 days.

Though the petitioners have come with a plea that they are ready and willing to deposit the said amount and delay in such deposit may be condoned, we are, however, of the view that such a discretion can be exercised by the Appellate Authority, PUDA and if need be, by the State Government in exercise of revisional jurisdiction.

We thus dispose of this writ petition relegating the petitioners to the above-stated remedies. The Chief Administrator, PUDA is directed to entertain the appeal and consider the claim of the petitioners sympathetically while deciding their appeal, preferably within a period of three months from the date of its filing.

Ordered accordingly.
