Petitioners are Cooperative Societies. They have approached this Court for writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent nos.2 to 5 to stop the illegal plying of buses by the respondent nos.6 to 15, without any route permit in District Sirsa under 2013 Scheme as they have been allotted their route permit in District Kurukshetra vide Annexures P1 to P10.

The petitioners have already conveyed their grievances by way of representations, Annexure P13, dated 12.1.2017, to the Transport Commissioner, 30 Bays Building, Sector 17, Chandigarh, and the Secretary, Regional Transport Authority, Sirsa (Haryana).

Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied, at this stage, in case the grievances of the petitioners is taken into consideration by the Transport Commissioner, Haryana.

Notice to the Advocate General, Haryana.

On asking of the Court, notice has been accepted by Mr.Kapil Bansal, DAG., Haryana, present in the Court. Copy given.

Without expression of any opinion on merits of the case, this petition is disposed of, at this stage, with a direction to the Transport Commissioner, Haryana, to consider the representation, Annexure P13, dated 12.1.2017, by taking into consideration all the attending circumstances objectively and pass a speaking order within a period of three months after the receipt of a certified copy of the order.
