It is the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner having completed the Course of Bachelor of Pharmacy in August, 2014 having obtained an aggregate of 3701 marks out of the total 7500 marks, the degree has not been issued to the petitioner by the Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar-respondent No. 1. He contends that The Swami Vivekanand Institute of Engineering and Technology-respondent No. 2 has duly recommended the request of the petitioner for release of the degree, as is apparent from the communications dated 06.04.2015 and 28.03.2016 (Annexure P-2 Colly). He contends that the representation dated 10.01.2017 (Annexure P-3) has been addressed to The Registrar,

petitioner but that also has not been responded to. Assertion has also been made that persons, who were similarly placed and were co-batchmates and students of the subsequent batch, have been issued provisional degree certificates, copies of which have been appended as Annexure P-4 (Colly.) but no reason has been assigned for non-release of the degree of the petitioner.

Counsel submits that liberty may be granted to the petitioner to file a detailed comprehensive representation to the Registrar, Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar, which will be submitted within a period of one week from today and direction may be issued to the said authority to consider and decide the said representation within some specified time.

In view of the above, in case the petitioner submits a detailed comprehensive representation to The Registrar, Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar, within a period of one week from today, the same shall be considered and decided by passing a speaking order within a period of one week of such receipt of the representation and convey the same forthwith.

This petition stands disposed of in above terms.
