These are two appeals arising out of award dated 25.1.2013 passed by the Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, Narnaul and are being disposed of by a common order passed in FAO No. 3490 of 2013.

FAO No. 3490 of 2013 has been filed by Insurance Company challenging its liability on the ground that there was delay in lodging the FIR.

FAO No. 1917 of 2013 has been filed by the claimant for enhancement of amount.

Learned counsel for the parties state that the matter has been compromised outside the Court and the Insurance Company has agreed to pay Rs.1,60,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal.

Learned counsel for the Insurance Company states that the amount already awarded by the Tribunal has been paid to the claimant and the same fact is admitted by learned counsel for the claimant.

Learned counsel for the Insurance Company states that the amount of Rs.1,60,000/- would be paid within eight weeks from today.

Accordingly, in view of the compromise arrived at between the parties, both the appeals are disposed of.
