The petitioner and respondent No.6 are admittedly related to each other. They have some property disputes which are concededly pending adjudication before the Civil Court. It further appears that due to inimical relation, some criminal proceedings are also pending against each other. The petitioner in the instant writ petition seeks a direction to the official respondents to take action against respondent No.6 for raising alleged unauthorized and illegal construction over a khasra number which has been declared as a part of 'controlled area'. As per the petitioner's own case, the District Town Planner (Enforcement), Gurgaon, has got registered an FIR.

In this view of the matter, no further direction is required to be issued by this Court. However, if the petitioner is so keen to seek a declaration that the construction raised by respondent No.6 is illegal and unauthorized, he may initiate proceedings before the Civil Court.

With liberty aforementioned, the writ petition stands disposed of.
