On 07.03.2017 the following order was passed :-

“The petitioner was initially not being offered appointment as Sanskrit teacher. He filed CWP No.20227 of 2010 that petition was allowed and the respondents were directed to appoint the petitioner as Sanskrit teacher. The petitioner was appointed and the present petition has been filed claiming that his seniority should be fixed from the back-date.

I put it to learned counsel whether this prayer can be now made when the same could have been made in the earlier petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks an adjournment.

Adjourned to 05.04.2017.”

Consequently, the petition is dismissed.
