Present petition has been filed seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct respondents No.3 to 5 to take action against respondents No.6 and 7, who forcibly dispossessed him of the vehicle, which he had purchased after taking loan from the bank, with a further prayer that possession of the vehicle be restored to him.

During the course of proceedings, a coordinate bench (M.M.S. Bedi, J.) directed the parties to amicably resolve the issue and come up with a final settlement. Today the bank has produced a statement of the outstanding amount (Rs.2,14,694.98 P.). Petitioner agrees to pay the amount. Admittedly, possession of the vehicle has already been delivered to the petitioner.

In view of this development, no further direction is necessary.

Needless to observe that on payment of the requisite amount, the bank will issue a No Objection Certificate to the petitioner without any delay. If amount of Rs.2,14,694.98 P. is paid within one month from today, No Objection Certificate (NOC) shall be issued by the bank within a week thereafter.
