The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition by way of public interest litigation under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.1 to conduct a thorough enquiry into the affairs of respondent No.4, which is indulging into storing the stocks of wheat at open plinths, despite the availability of its own covered godown at the same place.

2. The primary concern of the petitioner was that the

storing of wheat in open plinths at Elnabad, District Sirsa was required to be restrained.

3. It was not disputed by learned counsel for the respondents that in view of the affidavits dated 23.10.2017 and 17.10.2017 filed by the Food Corporation of India and State of Hayrana respectively in Civil Writ Petition No.4956 of 2015, the area falling in Elnabad, District Sirsa is also covered thereunder.

4. However, the aforesaid fact could not be disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner in view of the aforesaid affidavits which covers the entire State of Haryana. Learned State counsel submitted that the stocks which were earlier lying in the open plinths, has now been removed.

5. In view of the stand taken by the Food Corporation of India as well as by the State of Haryana, learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and prayed that the same may be disposed of as such.

6. Ordered accordingly.
