The instant writ petition has been filed to challenge the order dated 09.12.2016 (Annexure P-10) by which the Director Public Instructions had refused to entertain the claim for release of the Contributory Provident Fund under the grant in aid scheme to the petitioner-College.

In contempt proceedings i.e. ***COCF No. 3171 of 2014*** titled as ***Arya College, Ludhiana vs. Roshan Sunkaria and another***, a statement has been made that order dated 09.12.2016 shall be withdrawn and necessary steps shall be taken to ensure the release of the CPF to the petitioner-College.

Mr. Sachdeva, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner-College, submits that in view of the statement that has been made in the contempt proceedings, nothing survives in the instant writ petition and seeks to withdraw the same.

Dismissed as withdrawn, accordingly.
