The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 20.09.2016 (*Annexure P-2*) passed by Civil Judge (Senior Division), Bathinda, whereby the execution application filed by the decree holder has been dismissed.

It comes out that the petitioner seeks grant of proficiency step-up on completion of 8 and 18 years of service under the Punjab Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules 1988.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, I am of the view that the order has been passed in the execution application and appropriate remedy available to the petitioner is to avail remedy of filing appeal before the competent Court. The writ jurisdiction of this Court cannot be invoked to quash the order dated 20.09.2016 (*Annexure P-2*) passed by Civil Judge (Senior Division), Bathinda when the appropriate remedy is available to the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
