This common order shall dispose of above noted six writ petitions as they involve common cause of action.

The instant writ petitions have been preferred to challenge the advertisement dated 17.03.2016 inviting online applications for filling up

3336 posts of Computer Instructors and 3336 posts of Junior Computer Instructors on contract basis. The petitioners herein, who were already working on contract basis with the said Department since 2011, applied under the said advertisement but were aggrieved against the qualification that was prescribed for the posts so advertised.

The State Government has taken a decision, as noted in ***CWP No. 5884 of 2016*** and its connected matters, which were also filed against the same advertisement and listed today itself, to re-engage all those persons who were working on contract basis against their respective posts for the period ending on 31.05.2017. The relevant portion of the order of the even date passed in CWP No. 5884 of 2016 and its connected matters is reproduced herein below:

“Learned State counsel, on instructions received from Mr. Parveen Sangwan, Assistant Director, Department of Secondary Education, Haryana, submits that a decision has been taken that all those persons who were working on contract basis would be re-engaged on their respective posts for the period ending on 31.05.2017 and the necessary appointment/posting orders of all the petitioners would be issued on or before 28.02.2017.”

In view of the above statement made by the learned State counsel that the State Government has agreed to re-engage all the petitioners, no further orders are called for and the above noted petitions are disposed of accordingly with a direction that appointment/posting orders be issued to all the petitioners herein on or before 28.02.2017.
