The petitioner has preferred this writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents to refix the salary of the petitioner in the same pay scale as was being given to one Dhanpat Singh Dahiya, refix the pension and pensionary benefits by taking into consideration the last pay drawn and also refix the pension @ 50% of the last pay drawn salary of the petitioner alongwith interest.

It comes out that the petitioner has served a legal notice dated 18.10.2016 (*Annexure P-1*) upon the respondents. Now, the short prayer of the petitioner is that respondent No. 2 may be directed to decide the aforesaid legal notice of the petitioner within a specific time frame.

In the circumstances, without issuing notice to the respondents the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to consider and decide the aforementioned legal notice dated 18.10.2016 (*Annexure P-1*) of the petitioner by passing a speaking order meeting every

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contention raised in the said legal notice, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. If it is found that the petitioner is entitled for the relief as claimed in the legal notice, needless to say that the same shall be released to him forthwith.
