This order shall dispose of the above mentioned two petitions. By these two petitions the petitioners have challenged their transfer orders. These two petitions are actually cross petitions because if one is allowed the other unnecessarily has to be dismissed and both are claiming relief and transfer matter. It is not the duty of this Court to make a choice between the two petitioners. Both the learned counsel have fairly stated that the respondents are putting into the place of the petitioners new transfer policy as per the session 2017-2018.

In these circumstances, the only relief which can be granted to the petitioners is that they may move representations for transfer and the official respondents are directed to consider the same at the time of implementation of the new transfer policy.

Both the petitions stand disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
