KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

The petitioner has retired from service as Assistant Line Man on 31.05.2011. In the present petition, the petitioner seeks release of the pension and other retiral benefits along with interest.

In the reply, the respondents have taken the stand that the pension of the petitioner is to be fixed after counting the work-charge service rendered by the petitioner in various offices located at different places. Therefore, the service record is being collected and the absence period is to be regularized. However, necessary steps are being taken.

In these circumstances and keeping in view the fact that the respondents are not denying the claim of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the respondents to do the necessary paper work expeditiously and ensure that the pension and pensionary benefits along with interest as per Government instructions are released to the petitioner within three months from today.
