The petitioner has sought a rebate of the license fee on account of his liquor vends being closed in the State of Haryana during the particular period.

At this stage, it is not necessary to consider whether the petitioner was unable to operate his L-14A license on account of what transpired in the State as alleged by him or whether the petitioner did not operate the same for any other reasons. The petitioner has made an application in this regard to the Excise and Taxation Commissioner, Panchkula (Haryana) and he prays that his application be considered.

The petition is, therefore, disposed of by directing the respondents to have the application considered in accordance with law by any competent officer or authority. The respondents shall inform the petitioner in writing the name and designation of such officer or authority and afford the petitioner an opportunity of making a detailed representation to such officer or authority and an opportunity of being heard.
