This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No. 5 and 6 to settle the claims of the petitioner-miller in respect of 'B' class and 'C' class surplus gunny bags retained by the petitioner-miller after custom milling of paddy stored by respondents No. 5 and 6 in the mill premises of the petitioner during different periods from 2007 to 2015 as per the guidelines Annexure P-9 dated 24.05.2013.

In this context, the petitioner had issued a legal notice to the Managing Director, PUNGRAIN, Anaj Bhawan, Sector 39-C, Chandigarh and the District Manager, PUNGRAIN, District Office, Sangrur. Copy of the legal notice has been appended as Annexure P-19.

The interest of justice would be adequately met in case a direction is issued to the Managing Director, PUNGRAIN, Anaj Bhawan, Sector 39-C, Chandigarh and the District Manager, PUNGRAIN, District Office, Sangrur to consider the legal notice of the petitioner dated 21.01.2017 within a period of four months after the receipt of certified copy of this order.

Disposed of with above observation.

It will be the responsibility of the petitioner to communicate the order to the aforesaid respondents.
