Through instant writ petition, the petitioner claiming himself to be ex-President and present member of Arya Samaj Sabha, Ambala Cantt., seeks a direction to respondent No.1 to look into the representation annexure P-1 for conducting the fair and impartial election of the governing body of Arya Girls College, Ambala Cantt. after scrutinizing the entire record.

In this concern, a reference can be made to Section 39 of the Haryana Registration and Regulation of Societies Act, 2012, for short 'the Act', dealing with the elections and settlement of disputes.

The petitioner in the above said capacity claims that he has got a locus standi to approach the District Registrar who exercises the powers under Section 39 (4) of the Act and having jurisdiction of overall control and superintendence.

Petition is dismissed as not maintainable as election process has already started as per annexure P-7 issued by Returning Officer for election of Arya Girls College, Ambala Cantt. However, dismissal of this petition will not prejudice the rights of the petitioner under Section 40 of the Act.
