The petitioner has preferred this writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ of mandamus for directing the respondents to release the retiral benefits i.e. ex-gratia grant, insurance, gratuity, pension for a period of seven months and leave encashment in respect of her husband, alongwith interest.

It comes out that the petitioner has served a legal notice dated 18.11.2016 (*Annexure P-2*) upon the respondents. Now, the short prayer of the petitioner is that the respondents may be directed to decide the said legal notice 18.11.2016 (*Annexure P-2*) within a specific time frame.

In the circumstances, without issuing notice to the respondents, the present writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to decide the aforementioned legal notice dated 18.11.2016 (*Annexure P-2*) of the petitioners by passing a speaking order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
