This petition was filed to challenge the tender notice issued on 22.09.2016 for auctioning of 25 Paid Parking Lots within the territorial jurisdiction of the respondent-Corporation in a single lot initially for 3 years and extendable upto 5 years.

After notice, counsel for the respondent has put in appearance and submitted that the present petition has become infructuous because the General House of the Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh, in its meeting held on 28.02.2017, approved the invitation of fresh tender for operation and management of paid parkings in a single lot.

In view thereof, the earlier tender notice dated 22.09.2016 does not exist any more.

Consequently, the present petition has become infructuous and is dismissed as such.
