In the present petition, the petitioner has sought for preponement of the date of his regularization. The petitioner is stated to have been regularized on 30.9.2003 w.e.f. 1.10.2003. His intention is to change the date of regularization from 1.10.2003 to 7.10.1999 as long as rightly or wrongly his services have been regularized w.e.f. 1.10.2003. In the absence of challenge to the date of regularization mentioned in the order dated 30.9.2003, the petitioner is not entitled for preponement of date of regularization from 1.10.2003 to that of 7.10.1999.

Petition stands dismissed reserving liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh petition challenging the date of regularization mentioned in the order dated 30.9.2003 and seek for modification of date of regularization from 1.10.2003 to 7.10.1999, in accordance with law.
