Mr. Tajender K. Joshi, the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner states that the Chairman of the Commission is now available. In the circumstances, the purpose of the petition is served. No further orders are required in this petition.

2. The petition is accordingly disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to adopt appropriate proceedings whether before the Commission or otherwise. Only to enable the petitioner to do so and without expressing any views on the merits of the rival contentions including as to the maintainability of any other proceedings as may be adopted, the interim order granted on 01.03.2017 is extended up to and including 14.03.2017. It is clarified that in the event of the injunction not being continued by the Court or Tribunal, the respondents' liability to pay interest at the rate and on the terms and

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conditions stated in the interim order dated 01.03.2017 shall be applicable. In the event of the petitioner failing to do so, the respondents shall be entitled *inter alia* to apply in this petition itself for appropriate reliefs including for contempt. It is clarified again that we express no views whatsoever on the merits and maintainability of any proceedings.
