As per the stand taken in the written statement filed on behalf of respondent No.5, the election process was over by 28.02.2017 as election of Managing Committee was held unopposed, therefore, there was no question of holding election on 02.03.2017, it was only when there was a contest.

In view of the above, the petitioner, in my view, has efficacious remedy as per the statutory provisions of Section 102 of the Haryana Cooperative Societies Act, 1984.

Keeping in view the aforementioned facts, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present writ petition by relegating the petitioner to avail the remedy as per the statutory provisions of Section 102 of the 1984 Act

and in case, such remedy is availed, the Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Haryana, shall decide the matter as expeditiously as possible.

Disposed of, accordingly.
