On the last date of hearing, following order was passed in this case :-

“Counsel appearing for respondent No.2 submits that petition has been rendered infructuous as house has already been vacated by the petitioners. However, it appears that neither mesne profits nor litigation expenses have been paid. Matter is, thus, adjourned to 22.8.2017. Let intimation of the next date of hearing be sent to counsel representing petitioners as well as respondent No.1 to apprise the court about the statement made before this court.”

Counsel for respondent No.1 as well as respondent No.2 submit that the house in question has been vacated by the petitioners. Mr. Bal, who represents the mother of the petitioners, submits that she foregoes her rights to recovery of mesne profits.

In view of above, present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as such.
